

Iowa High School and SCTP Target Incentive Program

In partnership with Midway USA Foundation, Inc. the Iowa Scholastic Clay Target Program, Inc. and Iowa Department of Natural Resources are proud to announce the Target Incentive Program (TIP). The TIP program is designed to help both school and club based competitive clay target programs raise money and establish a perpetual trust fund from which teams can draw from. The TIP program creates a simple, straightforward way for local programs to establish and contribute to a fund to help support their teams for the future.

Who may participate?

Any Iowa-based program registered with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources as an Iowa High School and Scholastic Clay Target Program is eligible to participate. How does the program work?

Your shooting team keeps track of your practice and/or competition targets shot. These may be targets shot in or out of season by your program. For each target your team shoots, you may send a minimum amount of one cent to the Midway USA Foundation. For the amount contributed, Midway USA Foundation, Inc. will match that amount. For all league and state championship targets shot during the course of the Iowa High School and SCTP season and registered with the Iowa DNR, the Iowa Scholastic Clay Target Program, Inc. will also contribute one cent/target to your team's account.

For example, your team shoots 15,000 practice targets during the course of the season and 10,000 competition targets. Your team would submit a check in the amount of \$250 (one penny/target collected) to Midway USA Foundation, Inc. Midway USA Foundation, Inc. will contribute \$250 to your team's account and Iowa SCTP, Inc. will contribute \$100 for a grand total of \$600. There is no maximum amount/target you can contribute and Midway USA Foundation, Inc. will match the amount, penny for penny or dollar for dollar. Creative fundraising can involve things like getting 'target pledges' for practices, league events, state shoots, etc. from local sponsors without passing any direct cost to your shooters and their parents.

How do we access our funds?

All funds collected and matched will be placed into an account with Midway USA Foundation Inc.'s Scholastic Shooting Trust. Programs may apply annually through a grant process for up to 5% of the account balance. Go to: www.scholasticshootingtrust.org for complete information on how to apply or to check account balances. Head coaches or their designated delegate will be provided access to the account.

How else can we raise money for our account?

Any amount of money contributed to your Scholastic Shooting Trust account will be matched by Midway USA Foundation, Inc. Your local fundraising creativity is the only limit to the amount of money your team can raise.
